

Kiel Institute Workshop on:

The Role of Public Research and Innovation Measures on Mitigating Climate Change

May 11 – 12, 2023 in Kiel, Germany

Information

Paper presentation

Part of the workshop is organized into parallel sessions, i.e., two sessions will be held simultaneously. The parallel sessions include 2-3 presenters. Each presenter has 30 minutes, we suggest 20 minutes of presentation and an additional 10 minutes for questions and discussion.

Technique

Travel Information

The Kiel Institute is located in Kiel, a city in the North of Germany located at the Baltic Sea.

Getting to Kiel:

You can reach Kiel by train. If you have to or prefer the plane, Hamburg Airport is the closest airport. From there we recommend the Kielius Bus (<https://kielius-onlinebuchung.de/>) which takes you in around 70 minutes directly from the airport to Kiel but only travels every 2 hours. The bus leaves directly outside at the terminal. Please be aware that sometimes paying by card is not possible at the bus, you find ATMs in the airport.

Alternatively, you can take the public transport from Hamburg airport to Hamburg central station and from there take a local train from there to Kiel, which leaves every 30min. However, the train also needs around 70 minutes, so it is seldomly the faster option. Sure, you can also take a taxi from Hamburg to Kiel, this should be around 100 Euro but depends on the local operator.

Getting to the Kiel Institute within Kiel: Local busses nr. 41/42 run every 15min from Kiel train station to the Kiel institute (Bus stop "Institut für Weltwirtschaft – Kiel". Since Kiel is not very large, anything is also reachable by foot or bike. While it does take around 40 minutes from the train station to the institute by foot. The path goes along the water front and is especially at the second half a beautiful walk (if the weather plays along).

If you are an enthusiastic cyclist, you can also use the public bike sharing system. You can enjoy 30 minutes of a free ride after activating an account for Donkey Republic. Please be aware that you have

to bring the bike to one of the stations visible in the app. There is a station directly in front of the central station and the closest station at the Institute is five minutes away at “Reventloubrücke”. Visit for more information: <https://www.donkey.bike/de/stadte/kiel/>

Food

During the workshop you shall not be left hungry or thirsty. We have organized catering throughout the two days of the workshop. There will be snacks during the coffee break, a warm lunch on Thursday and Friday after the closing remarks. So we are happy if you do not leave directly after the closing remarks and join us for lunch.

Thursday night will be the workshop dinner at Lagom (Düsternbrooker Weg 38, 24105 Kiel; <https://www.lagom-kiel.de/>), a beautiful restaurant right at the waterfront and only around 5 minutes away from the Kiel Institute. Notably, the places are limited for presenters and invited persons.

Throughout the two days, all food provided will be vegetarian and vegan options will be available.

Next to the sea front and close to the Institute, you also find some options for snacks, e.g. fish sandwich or also vegetarian options. To this end, we recommend Moby (Kiellinie 61a, 24105 Kiel).

If you arrive on Wednesday and searching for a restaurant, you will find many options around the city. For instance, the area around the Holtenauer Straße is popular for having lunch. Just to name a few: Medea (Georgian; Holtenauer Str. 139, 24118 Kiel), Haveli (Indian, Holtenauer Str. 100, 24105 Kiel), Hoi An Restaurant (Vietnamese, Jägersberg 6, 24103 Kiel), POI (Italian, Holtenauer Str. 152, 24105 Kiel), John’s Burger (Burger, Esmarchstraße 58, 24105 Kiel) and L’Osteria (Italian, Raiffeisenstraße 1, 24103 Kiel). For some of these restaurants you might need to reserve.

Accommodation

Many new hotels have been built in Kiel over the last years. Depending on budgets, the Unique by Atlantic Hotels (Kaistraße 30, 24103 Kiel), the Niu Welly (Andreas-Gayk-Straße 10, 24103 Kiel), the Romantik Hotel Kieler Kaufmann (Niemannsweg 102, 24105 Kiel), the Maritim Hotel Bellevue Kiel (Bismarckallee 2, 24105 Kiel) or as outlined in previous e-mails the Steignberger Conti Hansa (Schloßgarten 7, 24103 Kiel) are popular options. Just check the established platforms or directly contact us if you need any advice.
